

Terms & Conditions

1. This registration is binding once it has been received by Norwegian Promotion Group. The exhibitor is liable for the total stand and registration fees. The organizer makes the final decision on stand allocation. The organiser reserves the right to refuse any application.
2. If several companies will share a stand, each company must send in its own application form and pay registration fee. Only one of the companies fills in the total area of the stand and will be regarded as a main-exhibitor. The other names of the companies must be written on this application form. The stand will only get one stand number. The main exhibitor is by the organiser regarded as our contact, and will receive invoices, technical information etc. The main-exhibitor must send invoices to the sharing companies by himself. Sub-rental of exhibition space/stands is not permitted.
3. The organiser reserves the right to stop further registration or, if necessary, to reduce the area applied for if the exhibition is fully booked at an early stage. The organiser also reserves the right to refuse any application as may be deemed necessary. The organiser reserved the right to reject or exclude any exhibited goods or services which, in the organiser's opinion, do not pertain to the current exhibition's product groups. The organiser makes the final decision on the allocation of stand/stands.
4. A WALL STAND is put up with standard side and rear walls.
An OPEN STAND is a stand which the exhibitor wishes to mount in its entirety. The stand is normally supplied with several open sides and is preferably placed in an open stand block together with other exhibitors with similar stands. Such stands are not supplied by the organiser with walls or facial girders, but the exhibitor should never the less be aware that neighbouring stands may be put out with walls. The layout for this kind of stands requires advance approval from the organiser.
5. TERMS OF PAYMENT The application fee and 50% of stand rental is to be paid by registration. The rest will be invoiced when the technical papers are sent out. Failure to comply with the payment conditions may entail loss of the allocated stand area. In such a case, the organiser has the right to allocate the stand area to someone else. All invoices must always be paid before start of event. Local taxes and other duties will be added.
6. Only completely filled out application form and paid registration fee gives the right to be mentioned in the exhibition catalogue. Every exhibitor will be offered an opportunity to advertise in this catalogue.
7. For safety reasons all stands must have the personnel present during the opening hours for the exhibition. Exhibits cannot be removed from the stand during the exhibition without the organiser's written permission.
8. Direct sale is allowed without special permission.
9. There is a limited maximum weight per sqm in the exhibition hall. If the load of goods and equipment exceeds 500 kilos per sqm, this must be stated on the application form.
10. It is prohibited to announce or distribute posters, samples and advertising material etc. outside the allocated stand area, material can only be handed out from the exhibitor's own stand. Demonstrations, the handing out of samples, the use of audio-visual equipment, amplifiers, etc. must be carried out without causing a nuisance to the neighbouring stands and surroundings as such. Any complaints should be referred to the organiser, who has the final authority.
11. The exhibitor is responsible for any damage caused to buildings, furnishings, systems, equipment and persons. The authorities and the organiser's directives and instructions must be strictly adhered to. Any damage will be repaired at the exhibitor's expense. The exhibitor is responsible that his own equipment, products and stand material is necessarily insured.
12. Exhibitors must ensure all transportation, assembly, dismantling, storage, packing and towing away of their own goods and decor. All goods meant for exhibitors must be properly marked with the exhibitor's name and stand number. If the stand has not been dismantled and the stand area cleared by the end of the dismantling period, the organiser can arrange this at the exhibitor's expense and at his risk.
13. The organiser provides cleaning of indoor and outdoor public gangways. Any additional cleaning must be booked separately and will be carried out at the exhibitor's expense.
14. The organiser provides security patrol from the start of the event until the end of the dismantling period, but do not accept responsibility for exhibits, equipment or a third part's property. The exhibitor must arrange for all necessary insurance coverage.
15. Technical papers with regulations, stand positioning, order forms and price lists are sent out on expire of the application deadline. The regulations are binding for all exhibitors.
16. If the exhibition, due to situations which may be characterised as force majeure, must be cancelled, do not entitle the exhibitor to compensation or a refund of the stand fee.
17. Other terms that are not stated above are to be bound by the local regulations of Bella Center / Stockholm International Fairs and Norway Trade Fairs.
